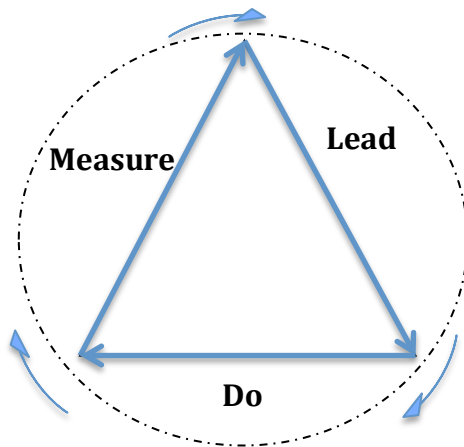


Community partners formulate feedback loops that help them compare what was planned to what was actually done and achieved, so as to inform and strengthen strategy, in a circular process.



Lead =

- Assess/reflect
- Strategize
- Plan
- Set criteria and measures
- Devise timelines
- Clarify and empower leadership roles

How are we doing? Checking-in at Regular Intervals:

✓	Community Partners Measurement Activity	Who collects?	When? (Evaluate at regular intervals, not just at the end)
	What work and activities have been done, versus what was planned		
	How long it has taken, versus the planned timeline		
	What it has cost, versus the original budget		
	The quality of things produced and delivered, versus what was planned		
	How people are responding to what was produced**, versus what was assumed		
	The benefits people are drawing from what was produced**, versus what was planned		
	You also need to understand the reasons why things are not going according to plan.		

**Get feedback from all beneficiaries and stakeholders, including those in the partnership
