Ingredients

- 1 Gallon of water
- 1 Cucumber, sliced
- 1/4 Cantaloupe, cubed into 1-inch pieces

Wacky Watermelon Water

Ingredients

- 1 Gallon of water
- 1/5 Watermelon, cubed into 1-inch pieces
- 4 sprigs mint

Spring Strawberry Refresher

Ingredients

- 1 Gallon of water
- 1 cup of strawberries, sliced
- 1 lemon or lime, sliced

Garden Pizza Water

Ingredients

- 1 Gallon of water
- 1 tomato, diced
- 4 sprigs basil

Fall Infused Fun

Ingredients

- 1 Gallon of water
- 1 apple, sliced, seeds removed
- 1 cinnamon stick
